Against all odds, the 1967 war marked a miraculous restoration of Jerusalem, Judea, and Samaria to the nation of Israel. These regions,

holding profound historical and spiritual significance, have always been the heartbeat of the Jewish people. Reclaiming and preserving these lands, however, has been a challenging journey, with obstacles such as propaganda, terrorism, and international opposition.

Many who commented on the article were Jewish people with specific questions about proper observance of the Day of Atonement. Others shared memories of past Yom Kippur celebrations. One woman's comment stood out to me. As she prepared to observe the Day of Atonement, she anxiously wondered how much forgiveness she could expect to receive. How would she know that she had been forgiven? Would she receive forgiveness for all sins, or only some? What about personal faults she couldn't seem to change?

Yom Kippur, the holiest day of the Jewish year, is the time when the Jewish people seek to be

A Jewish cemetery for over 3,000 years, with some of the most prominent Biblical kings buried in it, the Mount of Olives is one of these places. Standing on the top of the Mount of Olives, with a panoramic view of Jerusalem, particularly of the Temple Mount, one can appreciate the deep-rooted significance of this land. The view of the Temple Mount makes it a vital location for religious pilgrims and a symbol of Jewish heritage and continuity.

The Mount of Olives was historically used to grow olives, which provided oil for lighting the menorah in the ancient Temple, emphasizing its religious importance. If Israel were to cede this

creating a volatile situation akin to the Gaza Strip. This would not only threaten the safety of the area but also jeopardize the preservation of these sacred sites. Historical Islamic scholars have even noted that Jerusalem holds no significant religious status in Islam, with some arguing that the Al-Aqsa Mosque is in Saudi Arabia. area to the Palestinians, it would have grave implications. The Palestinians aim to claim all of Biblical Jerusalem, including the Old City and the Mount of Olives, areas integral to Judeo-Christian heritage.

This potential handover would place critical historical and religious sites under the control of groups like Hamas,

Many of the most important Jewish and Christian

sites in Jerusalem are within areas that the world often proposes to give to the Palestinians. If such a transfer were to occur, it would be catastrophic for both faiths. Jerusalem, Judea, and Samaria are not merely "occupied territories" or part of the "West Bank," they are Israel's biblical heartland — God's land.

"clean[sed] from all [their] sins before the LORD" (Lev. 16:30). According to rabbinic tradition, after Yom Kippur, one continues the new year with the past 12 months' sins hidden from God's sight.

With so much riding on these 25 hours, it's understandable that some are anxious to "get it right."

The 10-day period starting with *Rosh Hashanah* (the Jewish new year) and ending with *Yom Kippur*, known as the Days of Awe, provides ample time for self-examination. Those 10 days allow ample time for thinking through one's sins of omission and commission, reconciling strained relationships, and asking God to release us from ill-advised vows.

Are 10 days of repentance really necessary? Most of us consider ourselves good people. But that's not the issue, is it? It doesn't matter if we're good people compared to, say, a school shooter. What matters is if we're good people in God's eyes.

That brings us to the reason that God initially decreed *Yom Kippur*. In the Old Testament, He repeatedly called Israel to

be holy, as He is holy. Leviticus 20:26 is one instance of many: "You are to be holy to me because I, the LORD, am holy, and I have set you apart from the nations to be My own." Merriam-Webster defines holy as "one perfect in goodness and righteousness; divine."

None of us can claim to be perfect or divine. The Israelites couldn't either. Anyone who can't claim holiness needs atonement. It's that simple. Hence the yearly Day of Atonement, a time for the Israelites to practice self-denial, to refrain from work and pleasure. God said that on this day,

Atonement will be made for you ... to cleanse you, and you will be clean from all your sins before the LORD. ... [The High Priest] will make atonement ... for the priests and all the people of the assembly. This is to be a permanent statute for you, to make atonement for the Israelites once a year because of all their sins (Lev. 16:30–34).

God knew that His people would not live up to His standards, so He provided this way for their sins to be "covered over"



through the blood of sacrificed animals. However, the sacrifices on *Yom Kippur* had limited efficacy. The author of the Book of Hebrews wrote:

...The gifts and sacrifices being offered were not able to clear the conscience of the worshiper. They [were] only a matter of food and drink and various ceremonial washings — external regulations applying until the time of the new order (Heb. 9:9–10).

While *Yom Kippur* could only provide atonement for a limited time, it was God's sufficient (albeit temporary) provision.

There's one big problem with Yom Kippur today: There is no God-authorized way to make a sacrifice, since the Second Temple was destroyed in A.D. 70. As the author of the Book of Hebrews noted:

... The Law requires that nearly everything be cleansed with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness (Heb. 9:22, emphasis added).

In modern Judaism, prayer, repentance, and giving to charity have taken the place of sacrifices. But without the ability to observe *Yom Kippur* exactly as Scripture decrees, it's no wonder that some worry about the minutiae of Atonement Day.

The good news: Before the Temple's destruction, God provided a means of atonement even better than *Yom Kippur*. Hebrews 9:24–26 explains this "new order":

For [Messiah] did not enter a sanctuary made with human hands ... He entered Heaven itself, now to appear for us in God's presence. Nor did He enter Heaven to offer Himself again and again, the way the high priest enters the Most Holy Place every year [on Yom Kippur] with the blood that is not his own. Otherwise, [Messiah] would have had to suffer many times since the creation of the

world. But He has appeared once for all at the culmination of the ages to do away with sin by the sacrifice of Himself.

Hebrews 9:13-14 also clarifies:

The blood [of animals] ... sprinkled on those who are ceremonially unclean sanctify them so that they are outwardly clean. How much more, then, will the blood of [Messiah], who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from the acts that lead to death, so that we may serve the living God!

How can we have confidence that all our sins are eternally covered? By placing our faith in Jesus the Messiah, the perfect High Priest.

Yom Kippur is an important time of self-examination and repentance. But Believers* can rejoice that we repent as those who have received forgiveness!



- For Believers, Yom Kippur is an opportunity to focus specifically on self-examination and repentance.
 But the somberness of this day is tempered by the joy of knowing that our sins are already forgiven in Messiah!
- Even if you aren't Jewish or rarely observe Yom Kippur, consider using this time to draw nearer to God.
 Pray in the spirit of Psalm 139:23–24:
 Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.
- Pray for the Jewish people who do not know their Messiah. Pray that as they observe Yom Kippur this year, their hearts will be open to Yeshua (Jesus) and the perfect atonement that He offers.

(Actually, it was Florida — but we met with some Washington, D.C. insiders!)

What would you do if a United States congressman, who saved your life by extracting you out of a war zone, asked you to speak at a high-society political dinner? For us, it was a no-brainer! Rep. Cory Mills, from Florida's 7th congressional district, is the embodiment of Jimmy Stewart's character in *Mr. Smith Goes to Washington*. Rep. Mills is a legitimate civil servant, with the military background of Sylvester Stallone's *Rambo* character.

If you're unfamiliar with our story, our crew was filming in Israel in October 2023 when Hamas invaded. Nearly every airline canceled flights out of Tel Aviv. Our country left us behind, along with thousands of other U.S. citizens, while we wistfully watched every other nation send military aircraft to evacuate their people. Thankfully, Cory Mills answered God's call

(and ours, literally!) when he extracted our team and 43 other Americans from Israel.

This wasn't his first high-stakes rescue. In 2021, after the U.S.'s botched withdrawal from Afghanistan left 13 service members dead, Rep. Mills infiltrated the country on foot to extract a family of four Americans.

Nearly every week, without specifically searching for him online, you'll find the congressman achieving new feats of dedication and service — from rescuing 23 missionaries from Haiti as violent gangs overtook the country, to parachuting out of a plane over Normandy on the anniversary of D-Day. Because of his experience as a sniper, he also provided an invaluable assessment of the recent assassination attempt on President Donald Trump.

After receiving the invitation from Rep. Mills, we traveled to Daytona Beach, Florida. There, we met with his constituents and donors, along with other representa-

tives and senators, and told our story of God's supernatural deliverance through the hands of His servant. Thankfully, every politician at the Lincoln Dinner was beyond gracious to welcome two hairy Jewish guys who openly declare Yeshua as their Messiah.

Once again, the Lord gave us a platform to share His love and declare His truth as Rep. Mills gave us 12 minutes of his allotted speaking time. Rarely do we get to witness hundreds of cheering people in a packed convention center giving a standing ovation as we declare God's unbreakable covenant with His people Israel. After the recent barrage of hatred and anti-Semitism toward Israel and the Jewish people, it's a welcome relief to experience the support of Americans who recognize the importance of this country's greatest ally.

We can't shake the visceral memories of the war in Israel, nor can we stop marveling at how God uses Believers in government positions to do His will. Therefore, we continue encouraging Christians to take a stand, vote, and even run for public office. "When the righteous are in authority, the people rejoice; But when a wicked man rules, the people groan" (Prov. 29:2).

America's current spiritual climate parallels that of the Kingdom of Judah from over 2,500 years ago. Our country stands at a precipice — it will bring either one of the greatest moves of God or the collapse of one of the greatest nations ever to call upon the name of the Lord. Every one of us must make a choice. "Choose this day whom you will serve" (Joshua 24:15)!





On a recent trip, I spoke at a small congregation about prophecy and Israel. I was delighted to discover a group of Biblically informed Christians eager to learn the truths of God.

The pastor of this church is a fine teacher, with a degree from Moody Bible Institute. A person of obvious humility, this pastor told me he honestly did not feel qualified to teach on the prophetic Scriptures.

The pastor listened attentively to my talk with everyone else in his flock. I applaud him for his initiative in providing an opportunity for the congregation to understand End Times prophecy. For over an hour, we covered Israel's past, present, and future — a future that includes gentile Believers in the Millennial

Kingdom and on into eternity, where we all will dwell together — Jew and gentile alike — in the new Jerusalem.

While in Washington D.C., I interviewed Joseph Farah, Editor-in-Chief of World-NetDaily, an Internet news site with 2.5 million readers each month. Farah, an Arab-American and an Evangelical Believer, pulls no punches when reporting on issues like our war on terror, Israel's right to the Land, and bias in the media. Jews and Christians have a friend in Joseph Farah.

We rounded out our visit to the capital with interviews at the Israeli embassy. Off the record, I asked one staff member just why reporters in democracies like America or Europe continue to hate us. He smiled conspiratorially and

answered, "Because we're Jews." We are hearing more and more of that these days — bias and hatred against the Jews. As we have reported, our college campuses have become breeding grounds for anti-Semitism among academics and students alike.

In addition, we interviewed Mark Regev, the Israeli press liaison, who has appeared on Fox News and other networks defending Israel and its policies. Isn't it sad that the only democracy in the Middle East must fight tooth and nail to defend its own war against terrorism to the entire world?

Later, we spoke with an IDF (Israel Defense Forces) major who has seen plenty of combat. This 26-year-old explained the care taken by the IDF to arrest the terrorists from among the people without collateral damage. In the end, this officer had an optimistic view of future prospects with the Palestinians.

And finally, we talked with a young woman whose specialty at the embassy is Christian Relations with Israel. She was heartened by the support that Evangelical Christians were giving the Chosen People through donations, prayer services, and tourism. Of course, she was also quick to distinguish between U.S. Evangelicals and mainline Protestant denominations that, along with Catholics, give little support to the Jewish people. Most of the effective Christians are born again. The others simply don't amount to much in the view of the Chosen People.

This led me to consider again the question: Where is the U.S. in the End Times? Scripture is clear to those who take the Bible at face value: The best part for born-again Believers is in Heaven, attending our marriage to the Lord, not enduring the Tribulation. Leave the administration of the Tribulation period to the antiChrist, and to those unbelievers and Protestants and Catholics who have so diligently prepared themselves for that assignment.

The lines are being drawn more and more clearly today. Muslims are on the

offensive, attempting to convert the world "by the sword" through terrorism and violence of the most reprehensible forms. The Jews, however, are rapidly returning to the Promised Land, preparing themselves (though many are unaware of their Biblical destiny) for the time when the nations of the world will gather against them. They are defending themselves on American campuses, in European neighborhoods, and even in Israel.

Unfortunately, much of the world readily condemns Israel and acquiesces to the threats of the Arab states. The time is drawing near, I believe. And even though no one can or should dabble with dates, the pieces of the prophetic puzzle are coming together quickly.

There is no better time to lend your support to the Chosen People than now. Pray for them. Share Messiah with them. Visit them. Tell them that you love them, and that God will indeed fulfill His plan in them, ultimately exalting them and their Land above all other nations. If they won't let you say more, simply tell them you'll be leaving. When the Rapture occurs, your absence will become an irresistible piece of evidence for their salvation. And know that when you witness to the Jews, you may well choose one of the 144,000!

We provide opportunities through our many funds, through our television programs, and through our tours to Israel. Won't you consider helping the children of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob in this time of desperate survival?

"Make the most of your time because the days are evil," the Apostle Paul urges in Ephesians 5:16 (TLV). This is the time to make your voice heard, both to the Lord and to the world, that Christ is the risen Messiah, Who has come for Jew and gentile alike. Shalom, and pray fervently for the peace of Jerusalem!



Ask the Chaplain

What is the Apostasy of the Last Days? Part 1

The English word "apostasy," from the Greek word *apostasia*, refers to a religious defection, departure, or desertion from a previous stand or position. In secular Greek, the word referred to political rebels (Vine's Expository Dictionary of New Testament Words, p. 413). The New Testament, however, uses the word to denote people who forsake or abandon their faith in Jesus Christ and the revealed truth of God.

Jesus foretold this abandonment that would occur because of the proliferation of false christs and false prophets who will arise until His Second Coming (Matt. 24:5, 23-26). As a result, the Apostles were very concerned about people forsaking the true Gospel and sound Biblical doctrine. Though Paul, Peter, John, James, and Jude warned of this departure in their writings, it persisted throughout the first century.


In 1 Timothy 4:1-3, the Apostle Paul predicted a falling away from the Christian faith within the Church. The defection from the faith was already occurring in his time, and like leaven, will continue to spread until the end of the present age.


While apostasy has increased since the first century, Paul explained that there will be a universal "falling away" (2 Thess. 2:3) — a mass defection from and denial

of the Christian faith — prior to the rise of antiChrist and the subsequent return of Jesus Christ. Some Bible commentators believe that the "departing" mentioned in 2 Thessalonians 2:3 (in the Geneva Bible) refers to the Rapture, when all Believers in the Church depart from the Earth after Christ comes for them in the air (1 Thess. 4:15-17). But this thinking is flawed since the term for "departing," "departure," or "apostasy" usually refers to a defection from solid doctrine. This meaning is reinforced by the fact that the antiChrist will arise in the wake of this apostasy, bringing a universal abandonment of the Christian faith.

In 2 Thessalonians chapter 2, Paul specifically referred to the "unrighteous" deception" (v. 10) in which people depart from God's truth. In verse 7, he described this as "the mystery of lawlessness" —

Next month, we will consider how apostasy increases and its prevalence in our time.

Rhonda, Fares, and Todd

Robert Williams and I spent several days in Jerusalem during our 55th Gospel outreach in March 2024. Upon arriving at the Dan Hotel in Jerusalem, two employees greeted us: **Rhonda** and **Fares**. They are Arab Israelis. When we mentioned the Gaza war, they expressed sorrow over the Hamas atrocities on October 7. They added that they were glad to be Israeli citizens. This dispels the media notion that Jews and Arabs in Israel are perpetually at each other's throats. Actually, most of them live together in peace and happiness.

The mindset of Rhonda and Fares prompted Robert and me to proclaim the Gospel of Yeshua (Jesus) and how He died on the Cross to reconcile the world to God (2 Cor. 5:19). We added that this reconciliation is only effective for those who trust what Yeshua did. We then offered Rhonda and Fares a Hebrew Bible, containing both the Old and New Testaments. Both of them were excited to receive the Scriptures about the Jewish Messiah. He also loves and died for the Arab people and all people groups of the Earth, that whoever believes in Him might be saved (Isa. 45:22; John 3:16; Acts 16:31).

Later, we met Mor, who owns a jewelry store. She was very open to our message — it was as if she had been waiting for us to bring her the Good News of Yeshua the Messiah! We encouraged Mor with the Biblical promise of Jeremiah 31:31–37, where God confirms the preservation and redemption of the Jewish nation of Israel.

Robert and I explained that the Lord made this great promise within His larger pledge to make a New Covenant with Israel, unlike the Old Covenant He made at Mount Sinai, which Israel failed to keep. Mor was captivated by what this meant for the Jewish people. We added that the sacrificial death of Yeshua the Messiah, whose shed blood saves and cleanses us from sin (Matt. 26:28; 1 John 1:7), ratified the New Covenant. This New Covenant was first received in Israel by those who believed in Yeshua.

Mor joyfully accepted a Hebrew Bible from us. Through God's Word, she can better understand the fundamental truths of salvation, especially Yeshua's saving power for all who believe in Him (Rom. 3:21–26).



A Note from Mark

The World is a Coal Mine ...

... and the Jew is its canary.

The phrase "canary in a coal mine" originated from 19th-century coal miners. After discovering that canaries are highly sensitive to carbon monoxide - an invisible, odorless, deadly gas — they began taking canaries into the mines with them.

If carbon monoxide levels rose too much, the canaries would show signs of distress or even die before the miners were affected. Consequently, the miners knew to evacuate. The phrase now metaphorically refers to early warnings of potential danger.

Today's incessant increase in anti-Semitism is a warning that it has become time to evacuate many cities around the globe — for coal miners (the gentiles) as well as Jews (the canaries). The hateful, violent bigots who target Jews today inevitably will pursue Christians tomorrow and others afterward.

Canary Mission publicizes the words and deeds of individuals and organizations who promote racism and bigotry - especially anti-Semitism. Beneath the banner "BECAUSE THE WORLD SHOULD KNOW," CanaryMission.org devotes sections to exposing students, professors, professionals, and organizations who have openly, publicly embraced Jew-hating. Their thousands of listings prove that flagrant anti-Semitism routinely exercised in broad daylight amounts to the bell tolling for the dissipating, 20th-century sentiment "Never Again."

The homepage of Canary-Mission.org features articles entitled, "UC San Diego Dept. of Ethnic Studies Appoints Anti-Israel Activist as First Palestinian Community Leader in Residence" and "Why Does Gen Z Support Hamas?" Their Blog titles include "Anti-Zionism is Anti-Semitism," "Anti-Semitism

in Congress," and "The BDS Movement: Do Americans Really Care?"

Jewish Voice for Peace (JVP) is an anti-Israel organization whose stated mission is to seek "an end to the Israeli occupation of the West Bank, Gaza Strip, and East Jerusalem." JVP staunchly supports and promotes the BDS (Boycott, Divestment and Sanctions) movement in academic, cultural, and economic institutions. To read the in-depth report on JVP, visit CanaryMission.org/campaign/JVP.

The Ex-Canary section at Canary Mission. org offers a glimmer of hope. It features people who the watchdog group investigated and featured but have since rejected anti-Semitism. "These individuals have displayed the intellectual honesty to acknowledge the problem of anti-Semitism within anti-Israel organizations ... They have shown moral courage to recognize their earlier mistakes — despite social pressure from their peers."

Sadly, there are only 59 Ex-Canaries. With redacted identities and photos, silhouettes offer clues about their genders. Their accompanying statements begin with "I cannot take back the horrible things that I tweeted," "Everything I said was horrendous," "I believe I was brainwashed," and "Hatred is a taught behavior." Might these Ex-Canaries be one step closer to having faith in the Jewish Messiah?

Like it or not, on Judgment Day, every Canary and Ex-Canary will appear before the King of the Jews. 🌣

In the U.S. alone, 9,700 filed for aliyah from October 2023 through mid-May 2024, a 76% increase over the preceding corresponding period.

poral pleasures and fleeting dramas of this age. God has subjected this world to vanity yet has set "eternity within our hearts" (Eccl. 3:11) so that we abide in hope.

Meanwhile we regard all things as they relate to the truth of spirituality as taught by our Lord. We recognize God's moral law and the voice of conscience that overrules the vagaries of man's self-serving laws. We also understand that all we say, do, and think will be judged upon our death in light of the truth of God. We therefore look askance at worldly politics and the machinations

of the godless, understanding that we groan in this life and are burdened, earnestly desiring death to be "swallowed up" in life, so that we should be clothed in the immortality and blessing of eternal life (2 Cor. 5:4).

Just as you trust and accept that Yeshua was crucified for you — identifying with

you, taking your place in judgment, exchanging His life for your own so you trust and accept



Be Wise: Avoid Scams Part 1

You're probably familiar with the scams where you receive an email claiming that you won something. We all get those, and hopefully you ignore them. But other scams are more diabolical, and it's easier to be deceived by these scams. You might consider printing and posting this list near your computer.

Rules for Avoiding Scams

- Never pay money to receive money. If you are told you must pay shipping or
 processing fees or upgrade your account in order to receive money, it is a scam.
- Don't accept checks from strangers. You may think that the check you've
 deposited has cleared because your bank has updated your balance, but they
 must do that fairly quickly. It can take up to a month for a bad check to bounce
 and then the amount will be removed from your account.
- Never send money to strangers using services like Zelle, Venmo, or PayPal Friends and Family. These services are for sending money to people you know personally. The transactions are not reversible by the sender.
- Don't return money that you received "accidentally." Beware if someone contacts you saying that they unintentionally sent money to you and asking you to please return it. Their "money" is fake they want you to send your real money to their account. You might contact the service to reverse the transaction, but don't send money to strangers.
- Ignore "wrong number" text messages. Random, unexpected messages are used to start conversations that will lead to a scam. Don't befriend anonymous people!
- **Do not send a code** you receive by text or email to anyone online. They claim that they need you to do this to confirm your identity or help them get back into their account. This tactic is actually being used to break into your account.
- Never let a stranger access your computer by remote access. They can quickly corrupt your PC or Mac in order to defraud you.
- Resist pressure to act quickly. If anyone insists that you act immediately or something bad will happen, it's a scam.
- If someone claiming to be from your financial institution calls, don't trust the
 call. Hang up and call your bank, credit union, or credit card company using
 their normal phone number.
- Never send compromising photos to strangers you're chatting with online, no
 matter what they say or what photos they send you. Once they get your photos,
 they will use those seeking to extort money from you.
- Never send money to a scammer, even if they threaten you. They will only demand more, but likely won't follow through with any threats. Block their messages.

Next month, we will review some additional signs of a scam. Until then, visit <u>reddit</u>. <u>com/r/Scams/</u> to read more about online frauds and how to avoid being victimized.


Dear O.I.O.,



Innovative Device Frees a Baby's

Stuck Shoulder at Birth

One of the leading causes of obstetric malpractice suits in the U.S. is injuries resulting from pulling, pushing, or twisting a baby out of its mother during a shoulder dystocia delivery. This is when the head has emerged, but the shoulder is stuck behind the mother's pubic bone.

In August 2023, a couple in the state of Georgia filed a lawsuit after their son was decapitated during shoulder dystocia delivery. [It was ruled a homicide in February 2024. —Editor]

The Yaari Extractor Veteran Israeli medical device entrepreneur Aaron Feldman was surprised to learn that there was no device to ease this dangerous complication occurring annually in at least 1.5 million births worldwide — and it's increasing as birthweights rise.

The standard protocol is to try a series of manual maneuvers to free the baby within a five- to seven-minute window before the baby asphyxiates because of compression in the birth canal. These maneuvers can fracture the baby's arm or collarbone. Even worse, 50,000 newborns annually suffer permanent brachial plexus nerve damage from the pressure exerted on the neck as doctors work to free the baby's shoulder.

In 2016, Feldman met Dr. Abraham Yaari, an OB/GYN (specialist in obstetrics and gynecology), who had returned to Israel after 20 years of practicing in the U.S. Yaari told Feldman about the shoulder dystocia problem and how he proposed to solve it. Their conversation led to the establishment of FetalEase, a startup that has developed the Yaari Extractor, the one and only device for resolving shoulder dystocia.

Why didn't I think of that?

This simple mechanical solution has a flexible silicone sheath held between two control arms.

Using the control arms, the physician introduces

the sheath into the birth canal, wraps it around the fetal shoulder

to disengage it from the maternal pubic bone, and

then turns the baby 45 degrees. Now the mother can resume pushing the baby out naturally.

"No force is put on the baby's head or neck, and it's easy to learn how to use," explained Feldman.

In a test at a hospital in Haifa, "We put a sensor under a birth simulator to measure force to the mother from our device compared to during different manual maneuvers. It showed that ours puts much less force on the mother." added Feldman

He and Yaari took the Yaari Extractor to worldwide conferences to demonstrate the device to doctors on a simulator.

"So many of them told us, 'I can't believe I didn't think of that.' But they wanted to see it used in a real case in humans. It took a long time to be able to do that because there's high sensitivity in trying new devices with babies."

Initial testing in India

Eventually, Dr. Rajnish Patel, director of a maternity hospital in India, tested the Yaari Extractor.

When the COVID pandemic delayed in-person training in India, Patel suggested that they send him a simulator and several devices, and then train him over Zoom. A month later, Patel called to report that he'd used the Yaari Extractor to free a 10-pound baby with shoulder dystocia.

Patel took a video of this and another successful use of the device. Fetal-Ease showed the videos at medical conferences to the same professionals they'd previously wowed with the simulated procedure.

The October 2022 issue of *Obstetrics & Gynecology*, the journal of the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG), published a paper about the success of the first few trial cases.

During a December 2022 conference in Milan, 60 obstetricians from around the world gave up their lunch break to attend a Yaari Extractor training workshop with Patel and Yaari.

Afterward, many doctors around the world wanted to know how they could purchase and test the Yaari Extractor.

U.S. clinical trials

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) granted approval to FetalEase to initiate a U.S. clinical study. Pending those results, the Yaari Extractor could be FDA-cleared and ready for the U.S. market in late 2025.

Feldman notes that the device has great potential for use in developing countries. "Our team is laser focused on getting this into the market because every day that goes by there are babies being born with injuries from this situation," he explained.

Family friends are currently coping with the extended physical aftermath of a shoulder dystocia delivery. Thank you again, Israel, for creating innovative medical devices! —Kirsten

Israeli Heroes

This Ultra-Orthodox Jew Saved 50 Israelis on "Black Shabbat"

On October 7, 2023, Eli Rott was spending Simchat Torah at his in-laws' with his wife and two children when rocket-alert sirens blared across Jerusalem. Almost simultaneously, at around 8:05 a.m., he received a call from United Hatzalah — for which he has volunteered for five years as a first responder — informing him to head south toward the Gaza border.


"I had a bit of an argument with my wife. She didn't want to let me go at first. She was terrified. Not that we even knew at the time how severe the attack was," noted Rott, a *haredi*, or ultra-Orthodox Jew.

Rott explained that he has a duty to save lives, and most in his community understand. "If a pregnant woman needs to give birth on Shabbat or an elderly person doesn't wake up, someone must assist them. My phone might ring in synagogue during the prayers and everyone is okay with it."

En route to Sderot, Rott was flagged down by a car that had been commandeered by soldiers from the site of the Supernova music festival at Kibbutz Re'im, where Hamas terrorists had killed 360 people. The vehicle's driver had died and two passengers needed medical assistance for their wounds.

"We got the two injured revelers into the ambulance and started making our way to the nearest hospital," Rott stated. "On the way, they began describing what they had gone through. I thought they were

tripping on hard drugs; it didn't seem real."

By then, information and clips of the atrocities began circulating on social media. But Rott, who only uses his phone for emergency calls on Shabbat, did not yet know the extent of the carnage. "When I arrived at the hospital, I saw chaos—blood on the floor, parents looking for their children. They

would open their children. They would open the back doors of the ambulance to check if their kid was inside." he noted.

After dropping off the wounded, Rott headed out again, passing the entrance to Sderot, where he encountered a bomb shelter filled with dead people. "I usually would stop to recover the bodies, but there was no time. Otherwise, we would not have been able to rescue the living," Rott explained.

In Ofakim, the police station became a makeshift hospital, with doctors and paramedics treating victims from across the region. After providing first aid to the injured, Rott traveled between Ofakim and hospitals in southern Israel six or seven times, transporting four wounded each trip. "We took the victims to Ashkelon, Ashdod, and Beersheba, switching it up so as not to overwhelm the hospitals," he explained.

In the afternoon, he was dispatched to Kibbutz Kfar Aza, where over 60 residents had been killed by Hamas and at least 18 others kidnapped. "When we arrived, it was scary, with much shooting and many rockets targeting the kibbutz. We only had a few seconds to find shelter, but there was none; we were on the street," Rott stated. "The wounded we rescued there were mostly from elite military units because they were the first to arrive to fight."

Over the course of the day, Rott saved some 50 people.

"It is written in the Torah that everything that can be done should be done to save

lives. On October 7, there was no Shabbat, *Kiddush* [the blessing to sanctify the beginning of Shabbat], or *Havdalah* [the separation blessing that ends Shabbat]. I did not pray, because this is what was needed. It was my *mitzvah* ["religious duty" or "commandment from God"]," he explained.

"On October 7, we needed everyone," he said, adding that the situation has changed since. "We need to find a way to talk to each other in order to find a solution. Unity is the most important thing," Rott added.



In March. Rott. a talented athlete and the first haredi Ninja Israel finalist, participated in the Jerusalem Marathon. "I ran in the Old City, looking at the holy places and thinking of all the wars we fought for these to be ours. We will not forget all those who fell in battle or the

hostages, who we will bring back and run with next year," he declared. 🌣





Palestinian Terrorist Handbook Taught at NYC Community Center

The Samidoun Palestinian Prisoner Solidarity Network announced in July on its Telegram channel that it would host group study events at a community center in Brooklyn, New York. The teachings focus on "Strategy for the Liberation of Palestine," a document published by the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine (PFLP) in February 1969.

In 1967, the Palestinian Liberation Organization (PLO) founded the PFLP—a secular Palestinian Marxist–Leninist and revolutionary socialist organization. Known for pioneering armed aircraft-hijackings in the late 1960s and early 1970s, the PFLP has been designated as a terrorist organization by the U.S., Japan, Canada, and the European Union.

The document in question outlines the PFLP's philosophies and strategies. Its objective is "to destroy the state of Israel as a military, political, and economic establishment." It also claims that any peaceful negotiated solution is a product of "the Arab bourgeoisie" [capitalist class] that must be countered by a guerrilla war whose aims cannot be achieved "except through armed struggle and a protracted popular liberation war."

ISIS Persecuting African Christians MEMRI.org

One harrowing consequence of the Islamic State's (ISIS) expansion in Africa is the indiscriminate slaughter, displacement, and harassment of the continent's Christians, often with little or no global attention. During the first half of 2024, the Islamic State claimed responsibility for killing 698 African Christians from the Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC), Mozambique, Nigeria, Mali, and Cameroon.

Of the fatalities, 319 were decapitated, while 379 were shot to death. Additionally, ISIS claimed to have kidnapped, but not killed, 63 Christians, and to have burned at least 1,049 homes, and destroyed 23 churches and 12 schools.

By country, 639 Christians died in the DRC at the hands of Islamic State Central Africa Province (ISCAP). Those attacks occurred in the DRC's northeastern provinces bordering Uganda. This amounts to about 92% of all Christian fatalities in the first half of 2024. In Mozambique, 29 Christians were killed, followed by Nigeria (23 Christian fatalities), Mali (4), and Cameroon (3).

Fatalities rose sharply in June 2024, when ISCAP claims to have killed 300 Christians — about 47% of the murders during the first half of this year.

ISCAP reportedly beheaded 314 Christians in the DRC, while five Christians were killed similarly in Mozambique. In the DRC, 325 more Christians were shot to death and 50 were kidnapped.

Why aren't these atrocities reported by the mainstream media? This should motivate us to pray more! —David ❖

Excavation Reveals

Splendor and Destruction in Ancient Jerusalem

Archaeologists excavating the main drainage channel that ran under the streets of ancient Jerusalem have uncovered a collection of artifacts. The well-preserved objects offer unique insights into the state of the city during its prime and at the time of the Second Temple's destruction in A.D. 70.

Inside the Second Temple Period drainage channel in Jerusalem

The channel ran below the bustling markets of Jerusalem at the foot of the Temple Mount and along the length of the City of David. While the channel was usually cleaned regularly by municipal authorities, archaeologists found that it

and abandonment that we witness here corresponds to the story of the process of Jerusalem's destruction."

Among the discoveries were a delicate glass vial, nearly perfectly preserved, several small oil lamps with soot still in them from use, various coins and beads, and a collection of ceramic vessels used

> to hold perfume and oil.

Zilberstein added that they uncovered a "large variety of pots and dishes" representing "nearly the complete tableware set of Jerusalem's residents." She noted that the collection came "from many houses and from different streets in town,

was half-filled with silt. According to Dr. Ayelet Zilberstein, excavation director for the Israel Antiquities Authority (IAA), this indicated "a gradual neglect of city maintenance. And indeed, this very neglect

thus presenting us with examples of almost all wares the city's merchants had to offer."

Archaeologists removed bags of dirt and silt from the channel and carefully sifted

them. The researchers discovered food remains, including grape and olive seeds, grain kernels, eggshells, and fishbones. The richness of the organic remains has prompted further laboratory testing to detect organic remains not visible to the naked eye.

The excavation uncovered "the detritus of the life above Jerusalem's main street," which was preserved "just as it was at the moment of the city's destruction," Zilberstein explained. "Small finds tell us a big story, from

Jerusalem's heyday of prosperity and splendor


when its streets bustled with life, until the city's ebbing moments during the rebellion against the Romans, and its total abandonment" after the destruction of Jerusalem and the Temple.

The drainage channel excavation, undertaken by the IAA in conjunction with The City of David Foundation, is ongoing. It is possible

that during the destruction of Jerusalem, rebels or citizens might have hidden in the channel or used it for other purposes. Previously, a dig in the area uncovered a preserved Roman sword, still in its sheath \$\infty\$

Muhammad Musri

Muhammad Musri is president of American Islam, chairman of the board of the Islamic Society of Central Florida, and supposedly an advisor on Islam and Muslims to various U.S. government agencies.

In a June sermon at the Muslim Community Association of the San Francisco Bay Area (streamed on YouTube), Musri stated:

A lot of Christians are leaving their faith, especially the young generation. The churches are emptying out. The Pew Research Center has shown that in the last 10 years, 28% of people have left the Church and became atheists or agnostics. They are not impressed anymore by the dogma that someone 2,000 years ago was crucified for their sins. They are searching for something

that is more meaningful, that is consistent with science and consistent with the principles that we know today. Islam is the answer for them, and we are jumping on the opportunities.

Musri noted that Muslims are buying church facilities "that have been there a long

time, but they emptied out," and are converting them into mosques. "We bought three churches so far ... and now we have one we are buying with a school ... Because we have to serve the same people." He asserted that "the people who are part of that community, one day will be Muslims."

Turning to history, Musri explained: "A hundred years ago [Christians] invaded the Muslim world, and they built missionary schools and destroyed Islamic schools and mosques. Today, we bring back the favor and turn their churches into mosques, and their schools into Islamic schools, and bring the light of Islam to here."

"I ask Allah to give Islam victory in this country."


